Homestead Publishing (Bel Air, MD) has successfully upgraded its Scoop editorial and news pagination system. Homestead Publishing produces several weeklies, including The Aegis, The Record and five distinct editions of The Aegis Weekenders with a combined total circulation of 127,000. Homestead Publishing is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Baltimore Sun Co., which is owned by the Tribune Company.

The upgrade from Software Consulting Services, LLC (SCS) in Nazareth, PA, included ScoopEdit V for news copy and editing, Content Manager for data organization, ScoopArchive for archiving and WebArchive for archive access by non-ScoopEdit users. Homestead Publishing uses QuarkXPress® with Scoop for news pagination. Homestead Publishing runs ScoopEdit for Macintosh with approximately 30 workstations. At Homestead Publishing, Scoop's cross-platform archiving solution combines Content Manager, which organizes data from articles housed on a Windows server, with the ScoopArchive running on Macintosh.

Along with the Scoop upgrade, Homestead purchased FotoWare applications from SCS for image processing and management.
